Not only has it been a delight for our foster parents to raise the new babies, but it has also been a wonderful experience to take the adult guinea pigs that were so totally feral, and help them turn into trusting, sweet, loving pets.

Transporting the L.A. 400 guinea pigs all the way across the United States was not an easy thing to do. It required an awful lot of coordination from many people. We were so glad there were so many people that were willing to help, house and distribute the guinea pigs.

Approximately 80 guinea pigs left from California. By the time the piggy train arrived to us, there were 23 left. MGPR kept nine of them and the rest went on to other rescues. We were so proud to be a

part of this endeavor.

The only reason MGPR has been able to continue doing this for 30 years is because of your generosity, and once again we are asking you to please help us continue this very important work. A lot of personal volunteered time and effort go into our rescue, but it also takes food, supplies, medicine, healthcare and yes, transportation. We can only do it with your help.
